Minutes of BoS Meeting

The agenda of the meeting is unveiled after the initial introduction of member to each other. The members discussed proposal submitted to Board of Studies of Department of AI & ML and resolved as follows:

- 1. The meeting began with BoS Chairman and HOD discussing the curriculum structure of R20 regulations to be adopted by students admitted in year 2021 onwards.
- Dr. E. Srinivasa Reddy suggested to replace Software Engineering course with Design Thinking in view of the branch objectives. But later it is accepted to be part of open elective courses.
- Members discussed the curriculum structure to be in compliance of APSCHE and AICTE.
- 4. Dr. G. Madhavi suggested to add MEAN (MongoDB, Express, Angular, Node.js) stack course as job-oriented course in III-I.
- 5. A detailed discussion has taken place on the syllabus of Semesters-3 and Semester-4 and all the topics for each subject are scrutinized carefully.
- Discussion on skill oriented and skill advanced courses lead to the inclusion of Advanced Python Programming, Mobile Application Development in the course-1 pool.
- 7. Cloud platform usage is much supported by all the members to deliver the courses.
- 8. Course structure is design is made in line with GATE subjects.
- 9. Members encouraged learning to be focus on self-learning and problem solving.
- 10. Related lab of every subject should reflect the contents of the concerned subject.
- 11. The variation in hours for the same credit courses, were streamlined to the rules.

- A candidate shall complete at MOOC courses as Professional Elective course 1
 & 2 in third year for a 12 weeks duration.
- Enrollment of MOOC course will be initiated from the date of commencement of classwork for Second Year – 2nd Semester.
- MOOC course completion certificate must be submitted on or before the completion of Fourth Year – 1st Semester to consider it for Regular evaluation. Otherwise it will be considered as Supplementary.
- Student has to pursue and acquire a certificate for a MOOC course only from the SWAYAM/NPTEL through online with the approval of Head of the Department concerned in order to earn the 3 credits. List of courses will be announced by the respective Board of Studies at the time of commencement of class work for Second Year – 2nd Semester.
- 13. The meeting ended with the resolution to present syllabus in the external BoS meeting for all courses in the II-I and II-II semesters under R20.
