The Chairman welcomed the members to the IQAC meeting, followed by the discussion on the items of the agenda which were circulated among the members and corresponding resolutions were made.

Agenda Point 1: Google Code Labs & Industry-Oriented

Chairman, IQAC requested the Google Code Labs SPOC to present the status of Google Code Labs and the ways how it can be best utilized for the aspiring students and faculty. Sri M. Sri Krishna, Joint Secretary, gave the information. The members were asked to prepare the students to utilize the best of it. Chair, asked the Industry-Institute Interaction Committee I/C to present the report of his office. The data of number of activities held and industries connected, students did internships and industry experts visited, acting as adjunct professors is given as a report.

The Chair along with the members browsed through the information and discussed over the possibilities of improvement in several dimensions.

Resolution 1: It is resolved to encourage the students to participate in more Internship activities and redefine the Industry Institute Interaction by involving the dedicated industry experts.

Agenda Point 2: Entrepreneurship Development

Chairman, IQAC requested the Entrepreneurship Cell I/C to report on the number of students aspiring to be Entrepreneurs and status in training. The members discussed upon the quality of thoughts, ideation, empathy-concern, prototype building and budgetary issues involved in their process.

Resolution 2: The Chair and members of the IQAC committee after a serious review came to a consensus that our students are doing well to be good entrepreneurs, the support of VDU of NUB is outstanding.

Agenda Point 3: Social Activities

Chairman IQAC, briefed the Social Activities and aspect of quality in service with a note of public feedback in the adopted villages and the CRDA in view of VVIT. The members also expressed their experiences. The NSS and NCC activities were also briefed by the concerned members. The members felt that the activities might be conducted during holidays also in order not to have much disturbance during class work.

Resolution 3: As per the unanimous decision on this issue, the Committee made a resolution to conduct more Social Awareness activities during the non-course work days for better yielding to the society from VVITians.

Agenda Point 4: Students Degree Completion and Quality of Teaching

Chairman IQAC, gave away a quick review on students degree completion from the first batch onwards. The members gave their opinions on the data. The rise-fall-rise in graph showed a swing in the degree completion, which was debated by the members. The Chair elicited that Quality of teaching could not be compromised while the activities for slow learners make up must be done at a continuous and lower scale of delivery.


Resolution 4: The committee resolved that a continuous schedule for the make-up of slow learners should be made.
